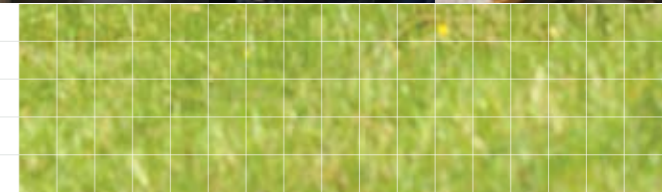
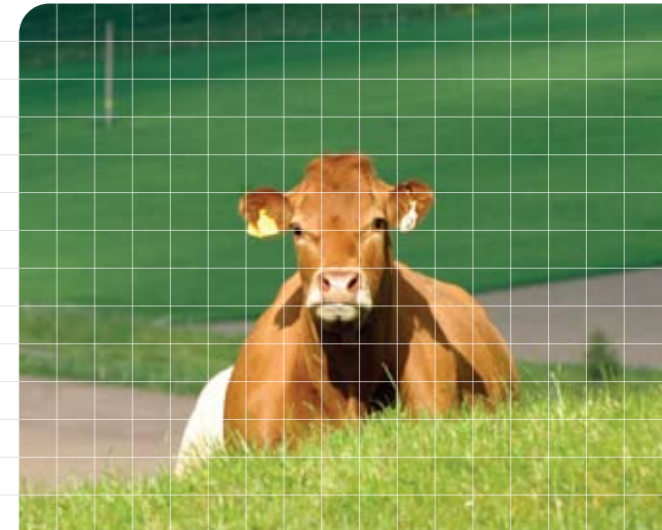

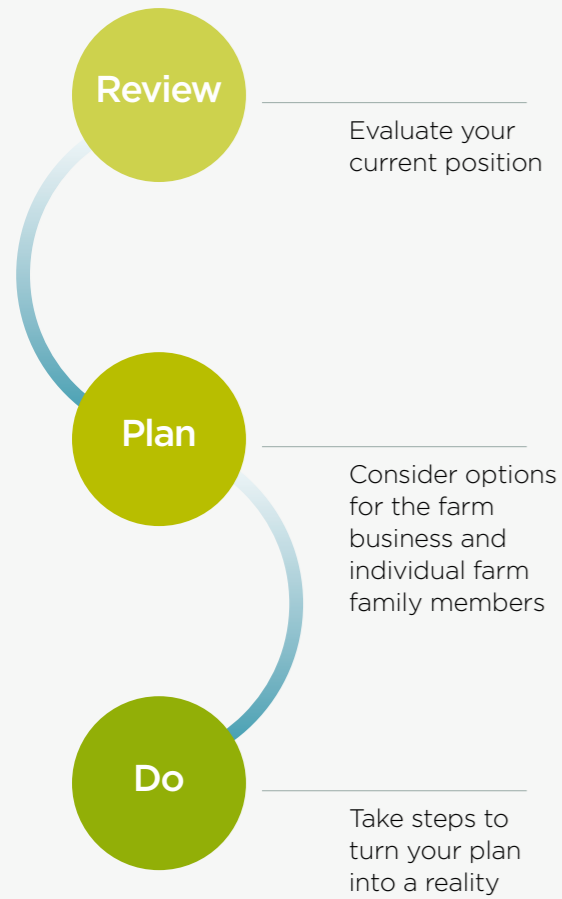

We can provide:

- Help to develop an Action Plan, including up to £250 towards financial and legal advice.
- Funding of up to £1000 per farm family member for training.
- A training allowance of up to £50 per day (maximum £250 per farm family member).
